

Cambodia ICT Camp 2018

I. Code of conduct

The Cambodia ICT Camp is a localized event that developed out of [the Mekong ICT Camp](#). The Mekong ICT Camp has been organized since 2008 for communities from Cambodia, Myanmar, Laos, Thailand and Vietnam with diverse backgrounds, covering three main topics: innovative practice, civic participation in governance and technology infrastructure.

This year is going to be the first time the Cambodia ICT Camp will be held in Cambodia for local participants from ICT communities. Open Development Cambodia (ODC) is committed to providing a respectful and safe environment to everyone engaged in the Camp. In order to ensure a successful experience, ODC requires participants, presenters and organizers to embrace the following code of conduct.

Diversity and Inclusivity

This Cambodia ICT Camp aims to create opportunities to involve people from all backgrounds while ensuring that no one is judged or discriminated against. Therefore, we welcome participants of all ages, cultures, gender and gender-identity, sexual orientation, ethnicities, languages, races, religions and backgrounds.

Harassment-free Camp

This is a harassment-free Camp and all activities in this line must be reported. We do not tolerate any form of misbehaviour nor harassment, regardless of physical characteristics, personal, economic or social background. These practices include all kind of offensive comments, intimidation in all forms, unwelcome verbal or physical behavior and sexualized images in public spaces.

Participants asked to stop any kind of this behaviour and are expected to comply immediately. It is at the discretion of the Camp organizers to sanction and expel anyone conducting any harassing practice.

Reporting Issues at Cambodia ICT Camp

If you are being harassed, notice that someone else is being harassed, or have any other concerns, please contact a member of conference staff immediately. Conference staff can be identified as they'll be wearing branded clothing and/or badges.

Please note that your report will be private and we will ensure that you are safe. Once we can provide you with the right conditions to make sure that you will not be overheard by anyone, you can freely talk about it with our staff. We will assist you in anything you might require to make you feel comfortable and safe.
